CHASSES DE PRESTIGE

Driven game pheasant shooting







In a very hilly territory of 1000 acres, you can shoot high-flying pheasants (25 to 45 meters high), in the purest English shooting tradition. The Taude, a river lined with poplars, flows through the estate over 2.5 miles. It is surrounded by hills with beautiful oak and chestnut trees. All the birds fly over these natural obstacles. They well defend themselves with speed and height.

- Hunting method.

A battue with a team of 12 guns. Dogs are also welcomed for battues.

- Organization of the shooting.

Meeting at 10 am, breakfast, departure of the hunt at 10.30 am. 3 drives during the morning. Lunch at 1 p.m. 2 drives during the afternoon. Trip back at 4.30 pm or 5 pm, with a drink and the bag. Dinner at 7 pm or 7.30 pm. (*only on request*)

- The bag.

The bag, because of the skill of the birds, depends on the competences of the hunters. Generally we have at least a bag of 150 braces. There may have a bag of 225 braces but the average is about 175 birds, with the same number of birds in the "line". If you wish it, you can ask for a more important bag.
